



**CALL FOR NOMINATIONS
J. MICHAEL ADAMS LEADERSHIP AND SERVICE AWARD
INTERNATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF UNIVERSITY PRESIDENTS
(IAUP)**

Established in 2013 by the IAUP Board of Directors (BOD) upon positive recommendation of the Executive Committee and a committee appointed by President Neal King and chaired by Dr. Jim Roach, this memorial award is to be presented at each triennial conference to an outstanding individual who exemplifies in her or his leadership and service in some aspect of international tertiary education the values and vision of both IAUP and the late J. Michael Adams.

It being the duty – per section 2.3.b.4 of the Byelaws - of the BOD to “set the conditions for the granting of Awards on behalf of the Charity,” the following shall be the process for determining this award’s recipient each triennium:

- A nominating committee comprised of the BOD Chair, the President, the President-elect, the Chair of the Council of Senior Advisors and the Secretary-General will issue a call for nominations no later than eighteen (18) months before the date of the Triennial Conference where the award will be presented.
- This call will be made throughout IAUP as an organization: General Assembly, Executive Committee, Board of Directors and Council of Senior Advisors.
- Nominations will be submitted to the Secretary-General on behalf of the committee and will be accepted from all interested parties.
- Nominees shall meet the conditions set forth in the preamble “an outstanding individual who exemplifies in their leadership and service in some aspect of international tertiary education the values and vision of both IAUP and the late J. Michael Adams.”

- The person placing a name in nomination should have direct knowledge of the individual being nominated and will provide the committee with her or his contact information.
- The nominations committee will recommend finalists for the award to the Executive Committee for this recommendation to the BOD no later than one year before the Triennial Conference where the award will be presented, in order to allow time for the recipient to be identified, invited to accept, etc.
- The IAUP BOD will determine the recipient upon the recommendation of the nominating committee and the Executive Committee, and shall extend the invitation to the intended recipient.

If you have a good candidate that responds to the profile indicated under d. please send the name, one-paragraph short bio of accomplishments, and contact information for the individual proposed. This should be sent to Dr. Gerald Reisinger, Secretary General IAUP, 2017-2020 at secretarygeneral@iaup.org Nominations should be sent between January 26 and April 15, 2019 in order to be considered by the IAUP Board of Directors.

The IAUP Board of Directors will determine the individual who will receive the award. We thank you in advance for your nomination, if you have any.
