Dr. Enrique Graue graduated from the UNAM School of Medicine in 1975 as a medical doctor with a Specialty on ophthalmology (1978) and then he completed postgraduate studies on biology and cornea transplant at the University of Florida.

He became Dean of the School of Medicine at UNAM in January 2008 and in 2012 he was reelected for the position. On November, 2015, he was designated Rector of the UNAM.

In recent years he received the Eduardo Liceaga award as well as the Medical Merit recognition, in addition to being distinguished with seven Honoris Causa Doctorates from national and international universities.

Dr. Graue has been President of the Mexican Ophthalmology Society, the Mexican Ophthalmology Council, the Pan-American Association of Ophthalmology, and Vice President of the International Ophthalmology Council. Currently, he is the President of the National Academy of Medicine.
